Computing

Computing is an essential tool throughout the school; from Reception to Year 6. Children are able to explore all aspects of computing, from control and coding to word processing and movie making. By the time children reach upper Key Stage 2 (KS2), they are confident users of a wide range of technical programming and extend their knowledge independently.

Curriculum

Staff provide inspirational and exciting lessons adapted so that children's computing skills are integrated into class topics. Professional development is on-going and staff are encouraged to update their skills and knowledge across the curriculum; supported by the Computing subject leader.

Teaching and learning

Children use both laptops and chrome pads which are all connected to our network. This allows access to the internet by a filtered broadband connection, providing safe access to the internet. Every class is fitted with an interactive Cleverboard, which enhances children's learning through interactive resources.
